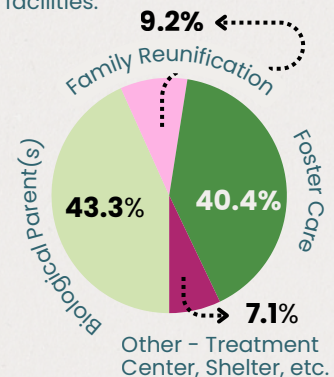
We assisted a total of 140 unduplicated children through HNM



Girls 64% Boys 35%

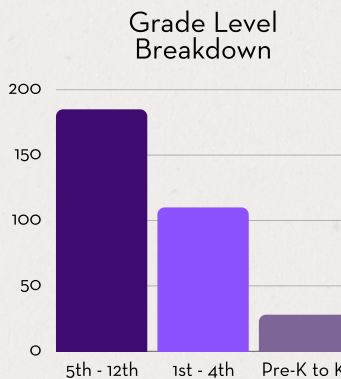
YOUTH PLACEMENT

Most requests come from youth with biological or foster families, but we also support those reunited with families or living in other facilities.



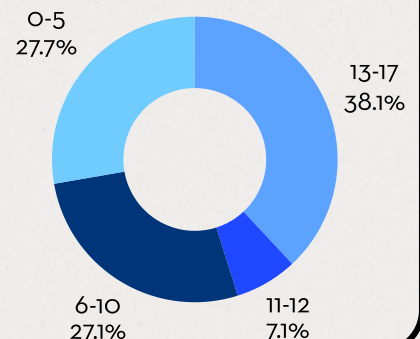
BACK TO SCHOOL
